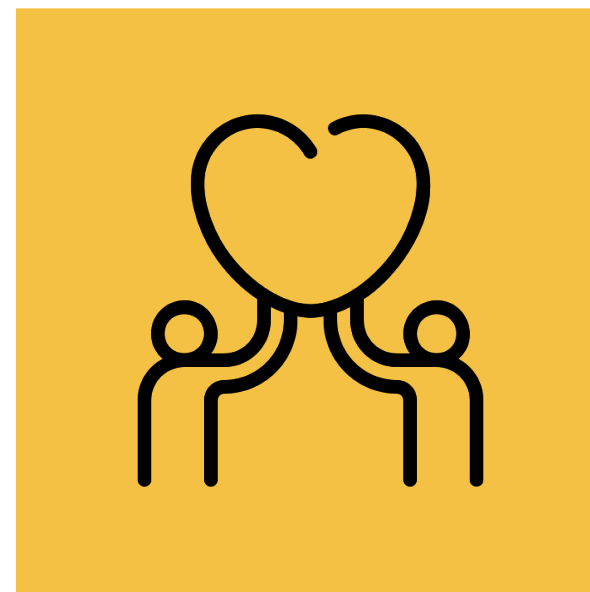
Non-governmental organization All-Ukrainian Association "Patriot" was registered on June 11 2014.

Since the beginning of the Russian invasion, the main purpose of its creation was to support the civilian population and the Armed Forces of Ukraine in the fight against the Russian occupiers who seized the Crimean peninsula, part of the Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

After Russia's full-scale invasion began, resisting the enemy became the main task of the entire country. Together with our team, we launched projects in three sectors: humanitarian, educational, and security.

## **1. Humanitarian sector**

We provide assistance to the most vulnerable groups of the population and support individuals and families who have lost their homes as a result of the war, as well as their livelihoods and security due to the occupation. We believe that quality medical care is an integral part of building a healthy nation, so we provide medicines, medical equipment, and necessary resources to medical institutions and rescue services.

## **2. Education sector**

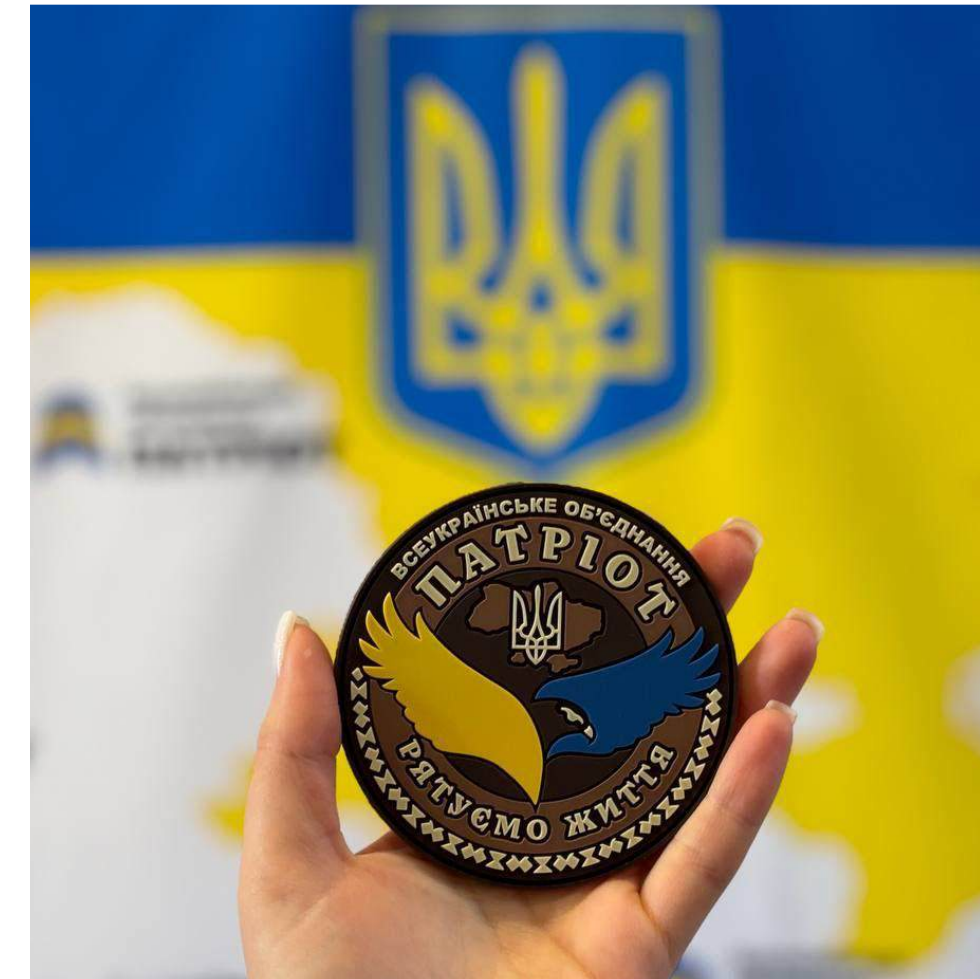
As part of our educational projects, we provide first aid training. The world becomes safe when the majority of people around you know how to act in a time of crisis, and can help the injured and wounded, and in doing so, can save lives!

## **3. Security sector**

Since the spring of 2014, we have been providing assistance and support to the units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine. From the first days of the full-scale invasion, we have been purchasing and delivering medical supplies, tactical equipment, machinery, medical evacuation vehicles, and much more to save the lives of the military.

# OUR PROJECTS

Within the framework of our projects, we cooperate with a large number of Ukrainian and international organizations, provide support to the civilian population, and provide medical facilities and rescue services with ambulances, necessary medical equipment, and medication. We travel thousands of kilometers on humanitarian missions to hot spots, take care of internally displaced persons from the occupied territories, teach people skills that help save lives, support hundreds of Ukrainian Armed Forces units and do many more useful things to bring the Victory closer.

We assist those affected by the occupation from the occupied territories and internally displaced persons. As part of the project, the "Patriot" shelter has been opened, which operates 24/7 to meet, assist, provide clothing, and feed people affected by the war

### Faces of the Ukrainian Dream

This is a project with which we want to tell the world about Ukrainian children and what they have gone through and continue to go through, about their own dreams and dreams for Ukraine through their drawings and stories.

The children of Ukraine had the right to a happy future, smiles, games, a cozy home, a friendly family circle, hugs from their parents, dreams, peace, and harmony. However, the aggressor deprived them of a normal happy childhood.

The stories of little Ukrainians and their drawings should convey to adult society that the war is terrible, and you must do everything possible to stop and defeat the world's evil.



### For Her

Our goal is to support women defending the country as much as possible so that they can feel comfortable and confident.

Women in the military are not just professionals in their craft. They are mothers, daughters, and sisters who risk everything to protect the country. At the same time, they have to overcome not only external challenges but also internal ones - stereotypes, prejudices, and sexism that still exist in the army.

The project "For Her" aims to change this reality: to create conditions in which a woman in the military feels supported, equal, and respected, rather than having to prove her rights on an everyday basis.

## Army Support

We enhance the army's defense capabilities by providing tactical equipment, gear, and other necessary items that fall within the main directions of assistance to units of the Security and Defense Forces of Ukraine



## Medical Armor

We deliver medical evacuation vehicles to the front, equipped with combat medic backpacks, individual first aid kits, tactical medicine supplies, and other medicines, including paramedics' medical equipment



## Battle Birds. "Bavovna"

Since the war's early days, we have been delivering quadcopters and "the big birds" to units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine and other military formations, allowing them to observe the enemy from the sky, act proactively, and save lives

We conduct free educational training for civilians on providing first aid in emergencies, trauma, critical bleeding, crisis conditions, and armed aggression cases

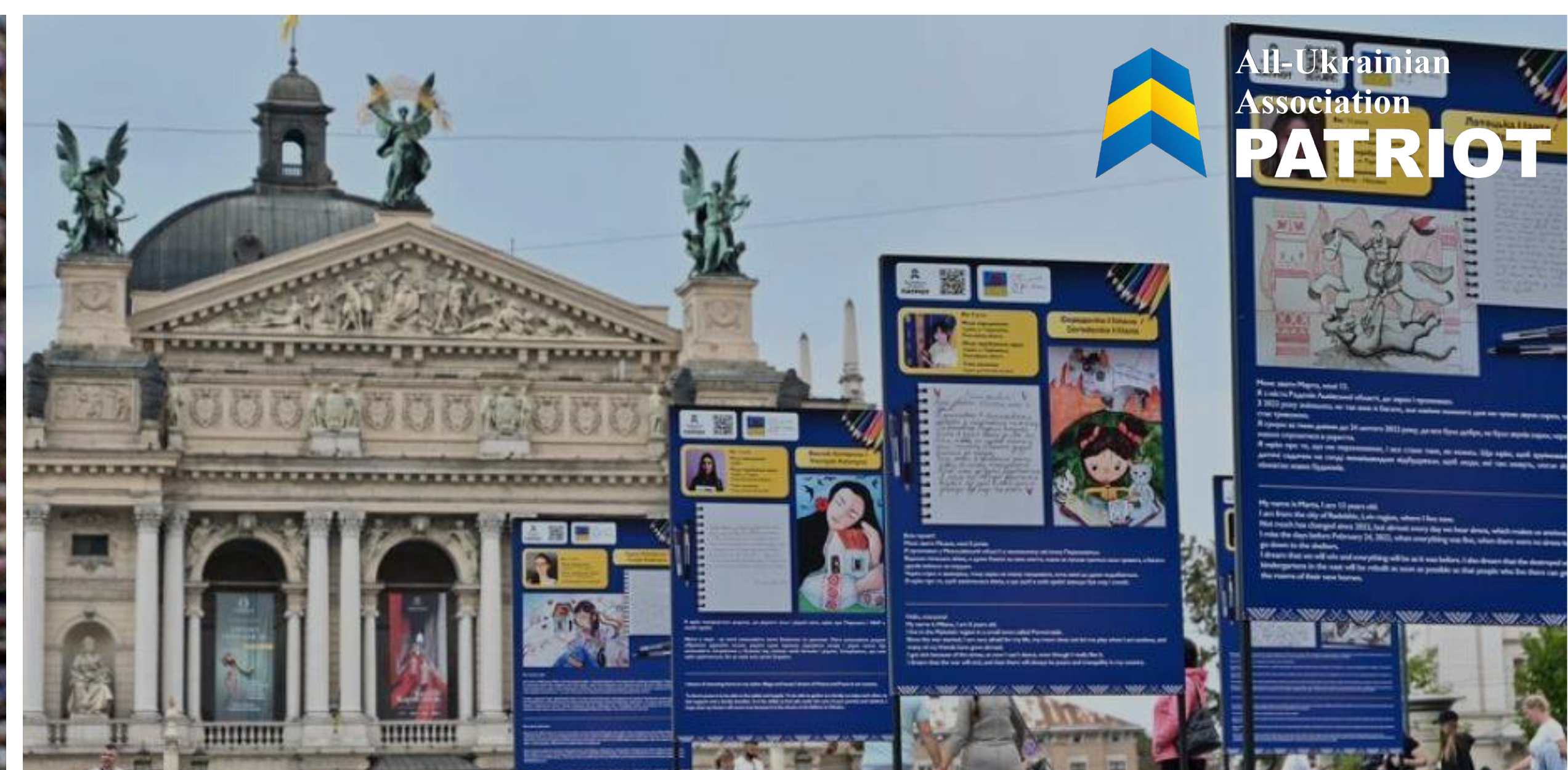

Under the “Medical Armor” project, humanitarian medical aid is regularly provided: backpacks for combat medics, medical aid bags for medical vehicles, individual military first aid kits, first aid supplies, medical evacuation vehicles, medicines, surgical instruments, dressing materials for military hospitals, and stabilization points.

# ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS OF OCCUPATION

In 2022, our representation in the Zaporizhzhia region set up an assistance point for families, operating 24/7, welcoming, assisting, clothing, and feeding people affected by the war.

Under the “Assistance to Victims of Occupation” project, we have established a temporary shelter for displaced persons from the occupied territories – the “Patriot Shelter” in Zaporizhzhya.

In June 2023, the shelter opened its doors to residents.

## SPENT TO MEET THE NEEDS OF THE SHELTER FOR THE 2024 YEAR

In 2024, we continued to improve the living conditions in Shelter. Various events are held for Shelter residents and guests, including mine and drone safety and digital literacy. A weekly robotics club was also launched this year.



The Shelter in Zaporizhzhia for war victims received a positive response from the Verkhovna Rada Commissioner and is included in the list of places of compact accommodation in Zaporizhzhia region, and the conditions we have created for people are considered one of the best.

- Temporary free housing;
- Free one-time meals;
- Psychological assistance;
- Assistance in restoring documents;
- Assistance in finding a job;
- Assistance in further evacuation

Since 2014, we have been providing assistance and support to units of the Armed Forces of Ukraine: military equipment, tactical gear, military equipment, uniforms, communication tools, night vision devices, sights, camelbacks, unloading gear, camouflage means, helmets, body armor, and much more, enhancing the defense capabilities of the Ukrainian Army and saving soldiers' lives.

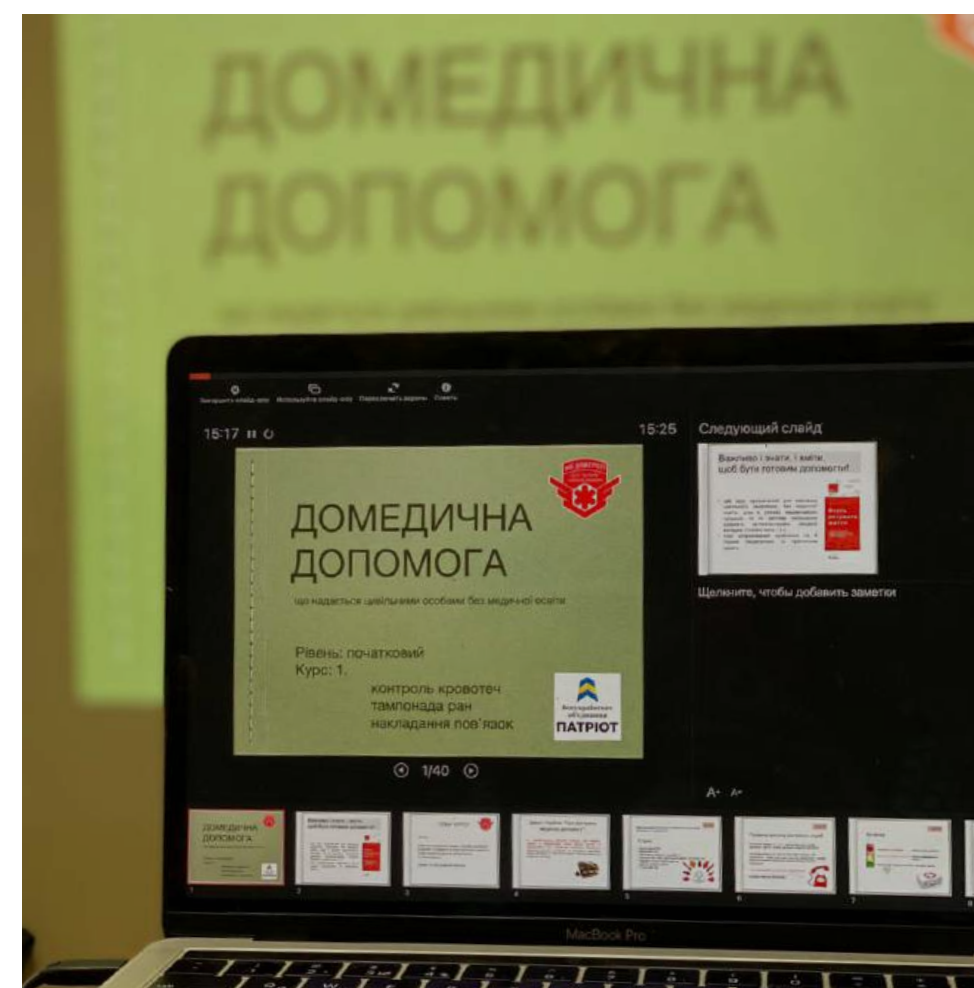
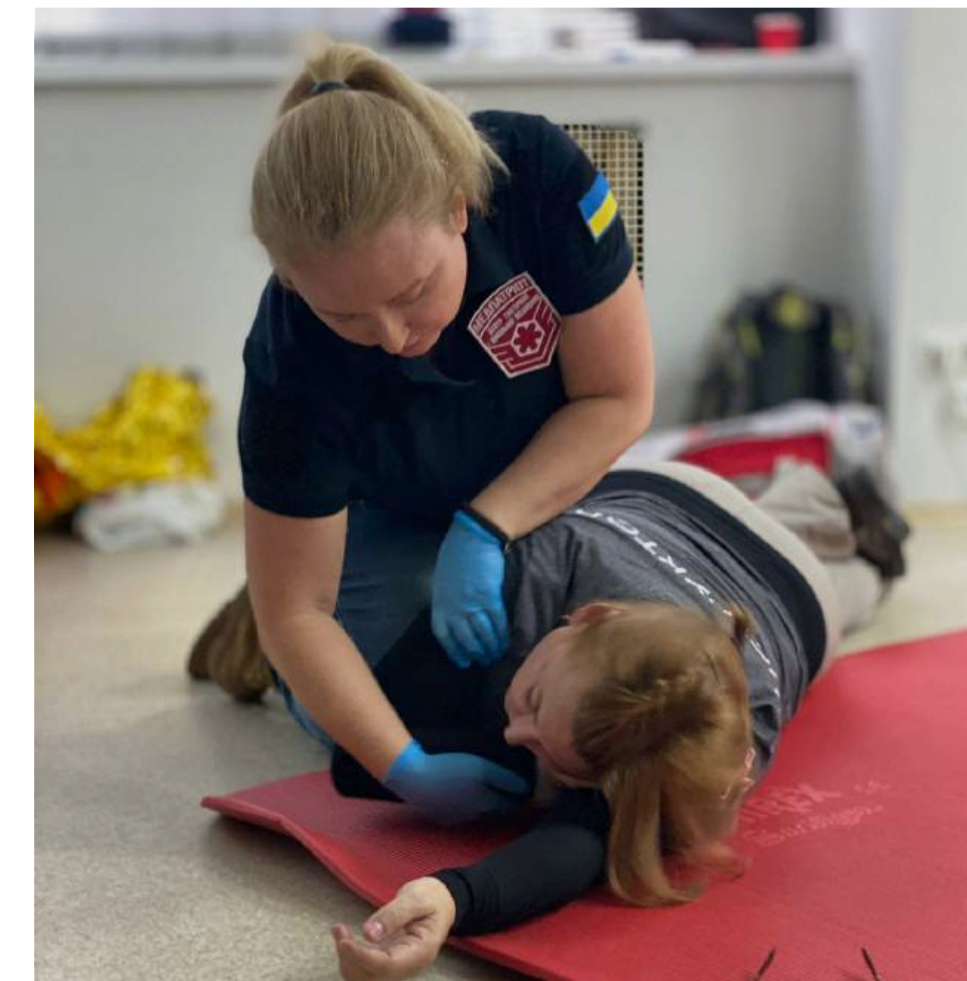

# LEARNING TO SAVE LIVES

We conduct free training sessions for civilians on providing first aid in emergencies, trauma, critical bleeding, and in conditions of crisis and armed aggression.

Our Courses and Programs for Civilian Population Include:

- Providing first aid in emergencies;
- Providing first aid in trauma cases;
- Providing first aid in critical bleeding situations;
- Features of delivering assistance and behavior in emergency conditions and armed aggression



# TACTICAL MEDICINE

Systematically, we train military and combat medics in courses on tactical medicine skills for providing medical assistance at the pre-hospital stage.

Our courses and programs for military and combat medics include:

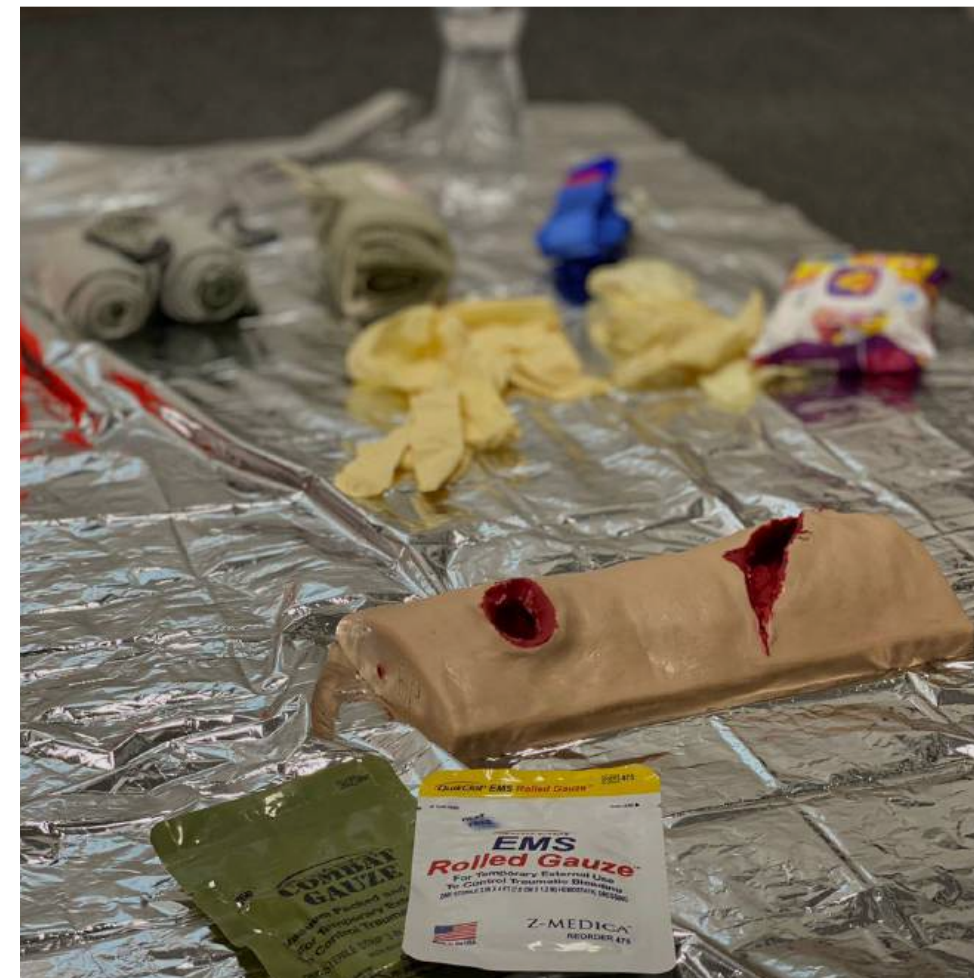
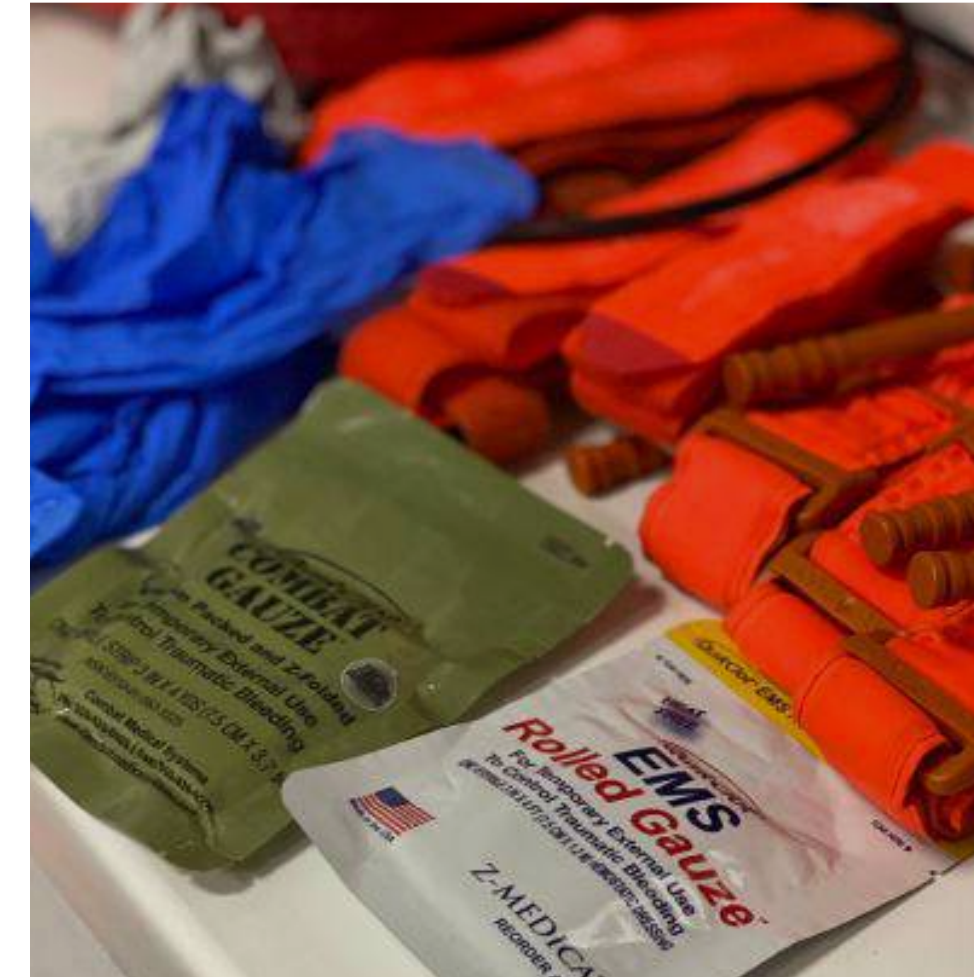
- Tactical Medicine Course according to TCCC Protocol – AC – self and mutual aid level;
- Tactical Medicine Course, according to TCCC-MR for medical personnel of units;
- Combat Medic Course;
- Instructor Training Course.



# STOP THE BLEED®

In 2024, the All-Ukrainian Association "PATRIOT" was issued a **STOP THE BLEED® educational license.**

It is estimated that more than 30,000 lives could be saved each year if more people had this basic, straightforward, but vital STOP THE BLEED® training. Key to the program's success are organizations licensed to teach DoD approved STOP THE BLEED® courses.

Opening our training classroom was an important step in the development of our organization. It allowed us to create comfortable conditions for training, provide access to modern equipment and training materials, and optimize the process of organizing and conducting trainings.

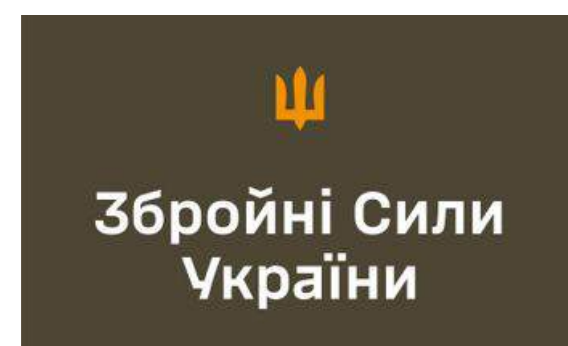

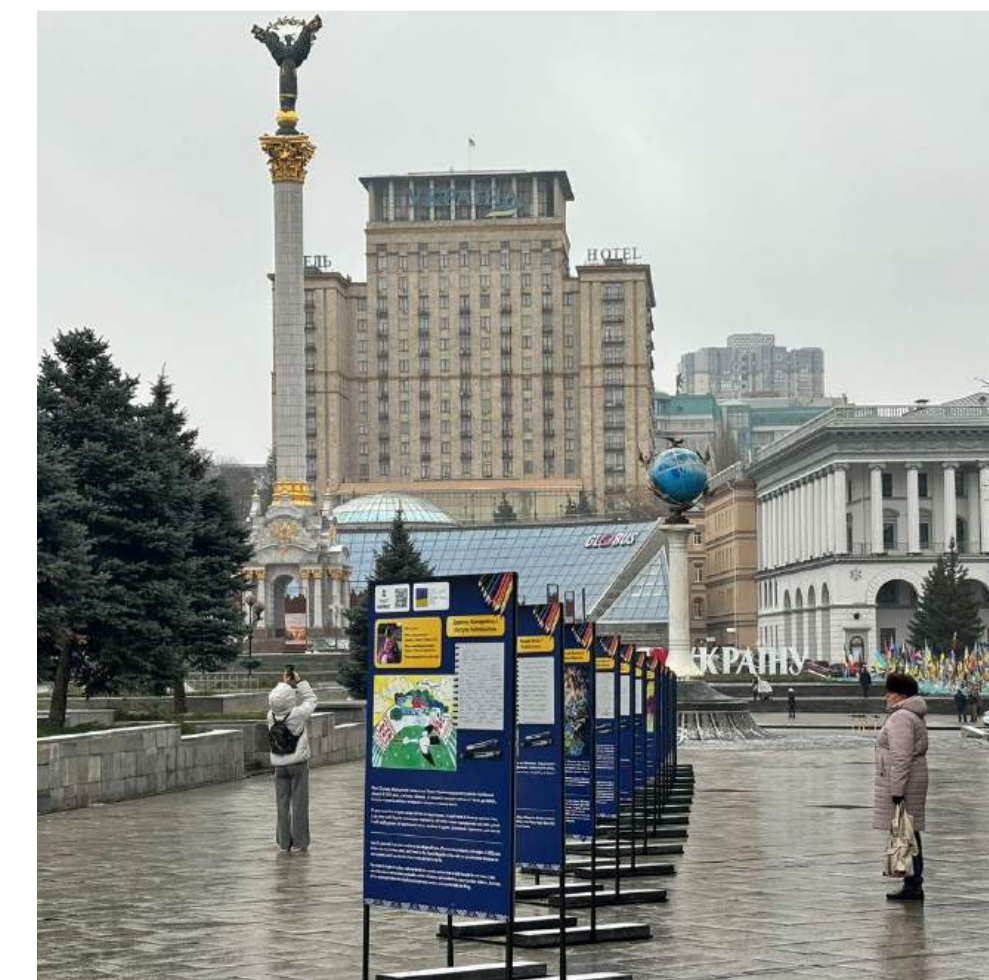

**215** - the number of participants works from **22** regions of Ukraine and **11** countries. We asked all potential project participants to create a drawing on one of the selected topics: "One Childhood for All," "My Dreamland," or "Ukrainians are Unbreakable." To the drawing, the children added a letter telling about themselves, the war, and their dreams.



One of the phases of the project is to hold exhibitions of children's digitized thoughts and drawings. Since June 1, 2024, children's works have been exhibited in Kyiv at 4 locations of Kyiv retailers and 5 street exhibitions in four regional centers (Kyiv, Odesa, Lviv, Dnipro).



We purchased 215 shoppers, T-shirts, caps, bracelets, and stickers to send gifts to different parts of Ukraine and the world. Each project participant received a gift and a participant's diploma, and by the decision of the partners, the project participants received outstanding prizes.

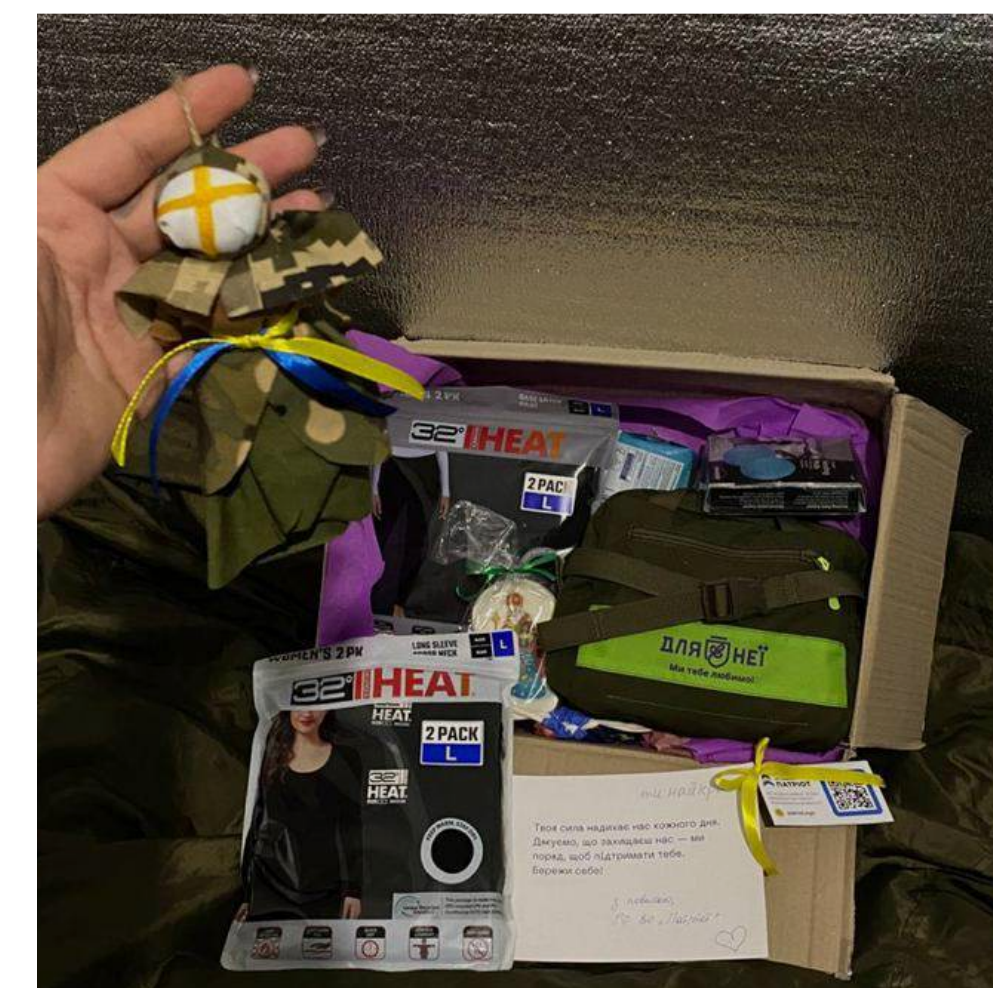
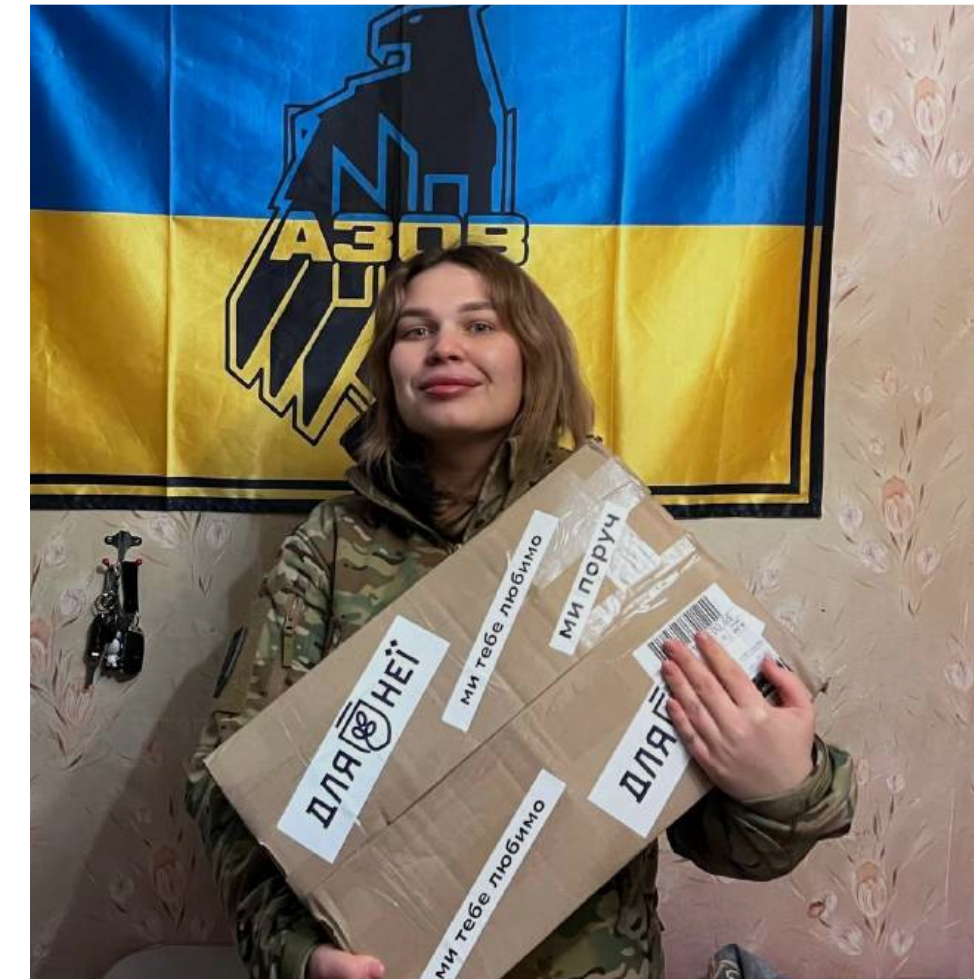

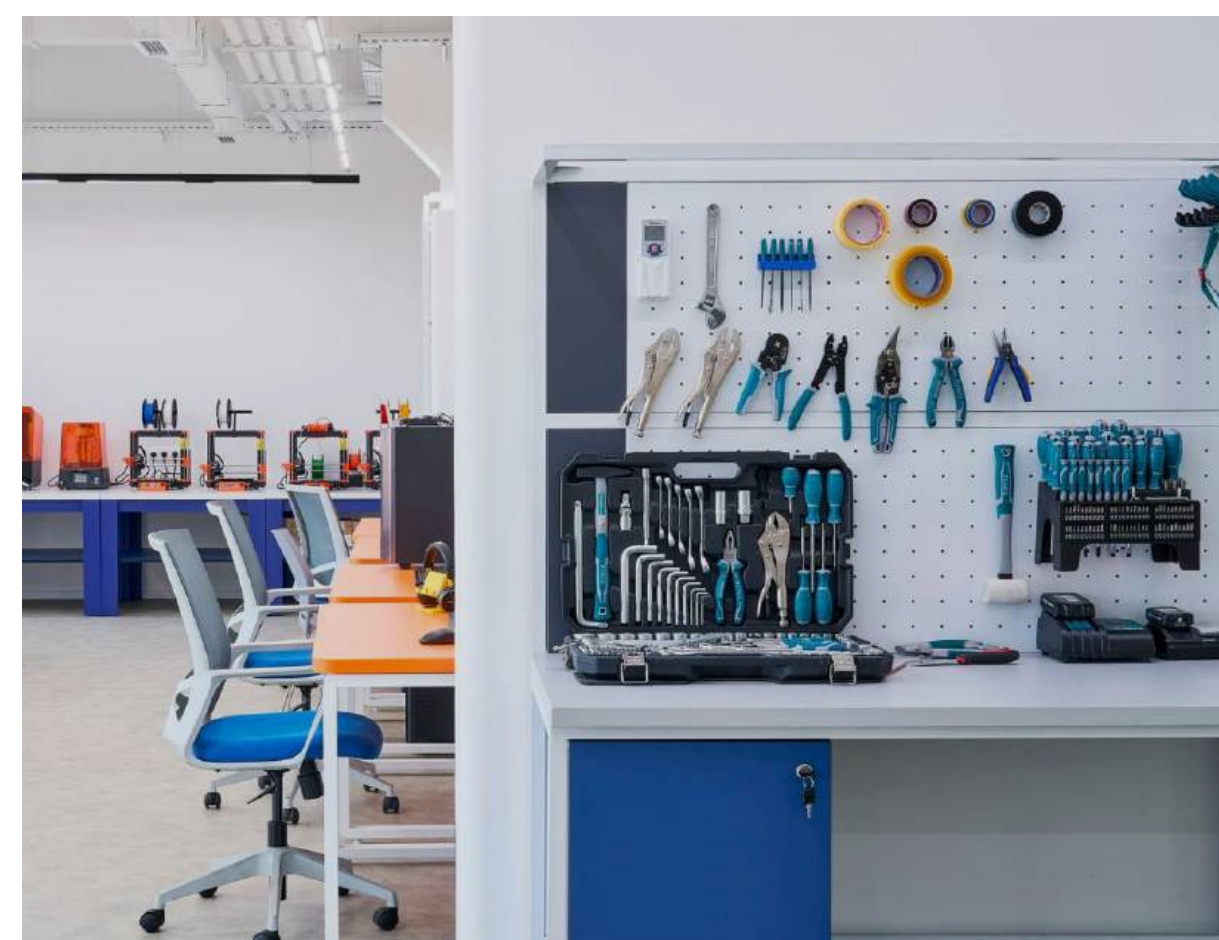
# TRAINING CENTER OF TACTICAL MEDICINE
