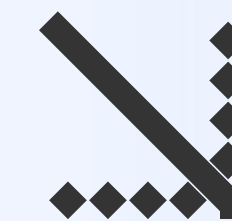

Since the beginning of russian aggression, the primary purpose of its establishment has been to support the civilian population and the Security and Defense Forces of Ukraine in the fight against russian occupiers who seized the Crimean Peninsula and parts of the Donetsk and Luhansk regions.

After the start of russia’s full-scale invasion, resistance to the enemy became the main task of the entire country. Together with our team, we launched projects in three directions: humanitarian, educational, and security.

MAIN SECTORS OF ASSISTANCE



SECURITY SECTOR

Since spring 2014, we have been providing assistance and support to units of the Security and Defense Forces of Ukraine. From the first days of the full-scale invasion, we have been procuring and transferring medical supplies, tactical equipment, gear, vehicles for medical evacuation, and much more that saves the lives of military personnel.



HUMANITARIAN SECTOR

We provide assistance to the most vulnerable groups of the population, implement support for individuals and families who have lost their homes as a result of the war, as well as their livelihoods and safety due to occupation. We believe that high-quality medical care is an integral part of building a healthy nation; therefore, we supply medicines, medical equipment, and necessary resources to medical institutions and emergency services.



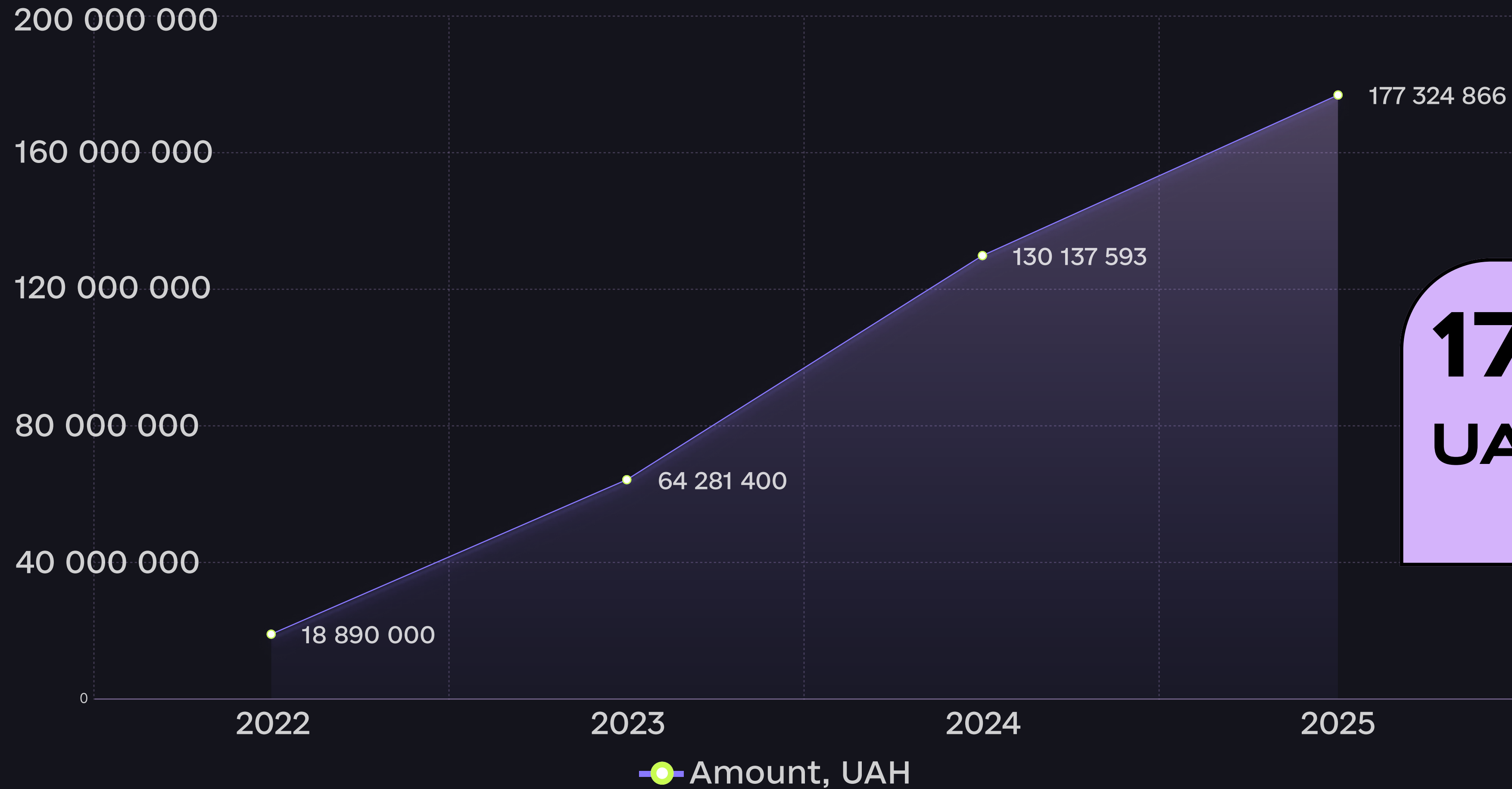
EDUCATIONAL SECTOR

Within the framework of our educational projects, we conduct training in medical aid skills. The world becomes safer when the majority of people around you know how to act in crisis situations, are able to provide assistance to the injured and wounded, and by doing so - can save lives.

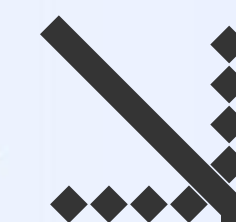
MEDICAL ARMOR

The project is part of the organization's systematic activities aimed at increasing the effectiveness of medical assistance and preserving the lives of wounded military personnel.

Within the framework of the project, humanitarian medical assistance is provided on a continuous basis, including the transfer of: backpacks for combat medics, bag-backpacks for ambulances, individual military first-aid kits, first medical aid supplies, transport for medical evacuation of the wounded, surgical instruments, and dressing materials for military hospitals and stabilization points.

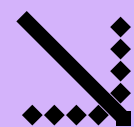

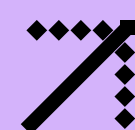
ARMY SUPPORT

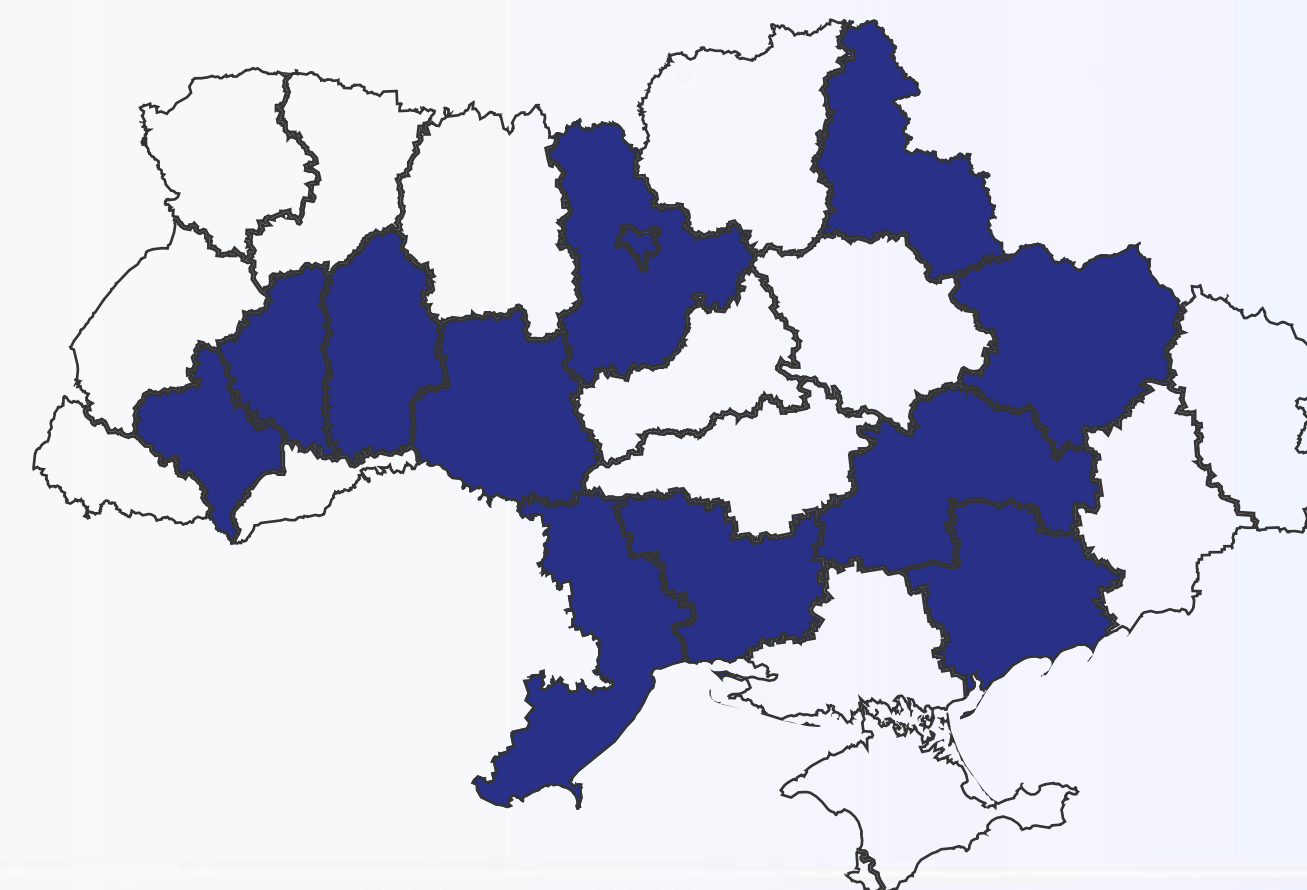

ASSISTANCE TO THOSE WHO SAVE

The project is implemented with the aim of supporting medical institutions and rescue services that play a key role in saving the lives of the civilian population affected as a result of the armed aggression of Russia, as well as in providing assistance to wounded military personnel.

Throughout the year, assistance was provided in response to current requests from hospitals and emergency services, taking into account the burden on the healthcare system and the real needs on the ground.

Hospitals of Ukraine, since 2014 and from February 2022, have become a real medical front.



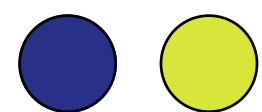
Thanks to cooperation with American partners, during the year it was possible to strengthen the material and technical support of hospitals and improve the conditions for the provision of medical care and treatment.

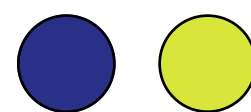

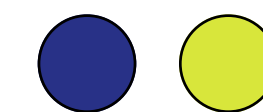

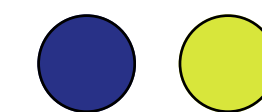

In the field of humanitarian assistance, sustainable international partnership is an important condition for the timely and continuous provision of medical institutions with the necessary resources. Each delivery includes not only transportation of cargo, but also careful logistics planning, coordination between the parties, and compliance with security procedures.

Humanitarian cargo from British partners made it possible to promptly respond to urgent requests from hospitals and maintain the stability of medical supplies.

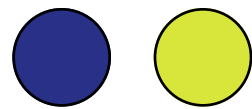

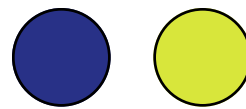

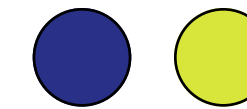

THE INITIATIVE “HELPERS OF SAINT NICHOLAS”

A separate important mission within the framework of the project was the organization of a large-scale collection and dispatch of gifts for Saint Nicholas Day to the project participants.

CARE FOR THOSE IN NEED

The project is aimed at providing humanitarian assistance to the most vulnerable groups of the civilian population who find themselves in difficult life circumstances as a result of the war.

The initiative unites the efforts of volunteers, benefactors, and partner organizations.

Throughout the year, the organization's team ensured the transfer of humanitarian assistance, including essential items, food products, and non-food goods for socially vulnerable segments of the population, as well as gifts for children. The project became part of the organization's systematic work aimed at supporting the civilian population and reducing the humanitarian consequences of the war.



ASSISTANCE TO ELDERLY PEOPLE AND BEDRIDDEN PATIENTS

In cooperation with Japanese partners - the “Association for the Support of Elderly People in Ukraine” - during the year, we transferred assistance that was aimed at supporting residents of frontline territories and medical institutions of Ukraine that provide care for elderly people and bedridden patients in the difficult conditions of war.

FOR HER

Since September 2024, our team has been implementing a project whose goal is to support women who defend the country, so that they can feel comfortable and confident. The project emphasizes the importance of caring for our female defenders and taking their needs into account.

The main stage of the project is the transfer of women's kits to the front line, containing organizers and specially designed tactical cosmetic bags for women serving in the military. They are mothers, daughters, and sisters who risk everything to defend the country. At the same time, they are forced to overcome not only external challenges, but also internal ones - stereotypes, prejudice, and sexism that still exist in the army.

The project "For Her" is aimed at changing this reality: creating conditions in which a woman serving in the military will feel support, equality, and respect, rather than the need to prove her right to be treated as an equal every day.

The boxes with hygiene kits that we transfer to female defenders contain essential items for military conditions, as well as small pleasant additions (care cosmetics, hygiene products, decorative cosmetics, accessories), thermal underwear, tactical accessories, socks, as well as coffee, sweets, motanka dolls, children's drawings, letters of support, and so on.

ASSISTANCE TO VICTIMS OF OCCUPATION - THE “PATRIOT” SHELTER IN ZAPORIZHZHIA

In 2022, our representative office in the Zaporizhzhia Region established a family assistance point which operated 24/7, welcoming, assisting, clothing, and feeding people who were affected by the war.

Within the framework of the project, we opened and equipped a temporary shelter for internally displaced persons from occupied territories - the “Patriot” Shelter in the city of Zaporizhzhia.

Since June 2023, the shelter has opened its doors to residents.

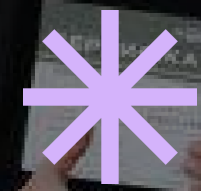

LEARNING TO SAVE LIVES AND TACTICAL MEDICINE

Within the framework of our educational projects, we prepare both military personnel and civilians to provide pre-medical aid in crisis situations.

Our goal is to teach as many people as possible to act effectively in cases of injuries, bleeding, emergency conditions, and in situations of armed aggression.

The geography of the projects covers the entire territory of Ukraine - from rear regions to frontline territories.

Within the framework of the project “Learning to Save Lives”, a team of qualified instructors trains civilians, in particular schoolchildren and teachers, in the basics of first pre-medical aid in cases of injuries, bleeding, and emergency conditions, including emergency situations related to the war.

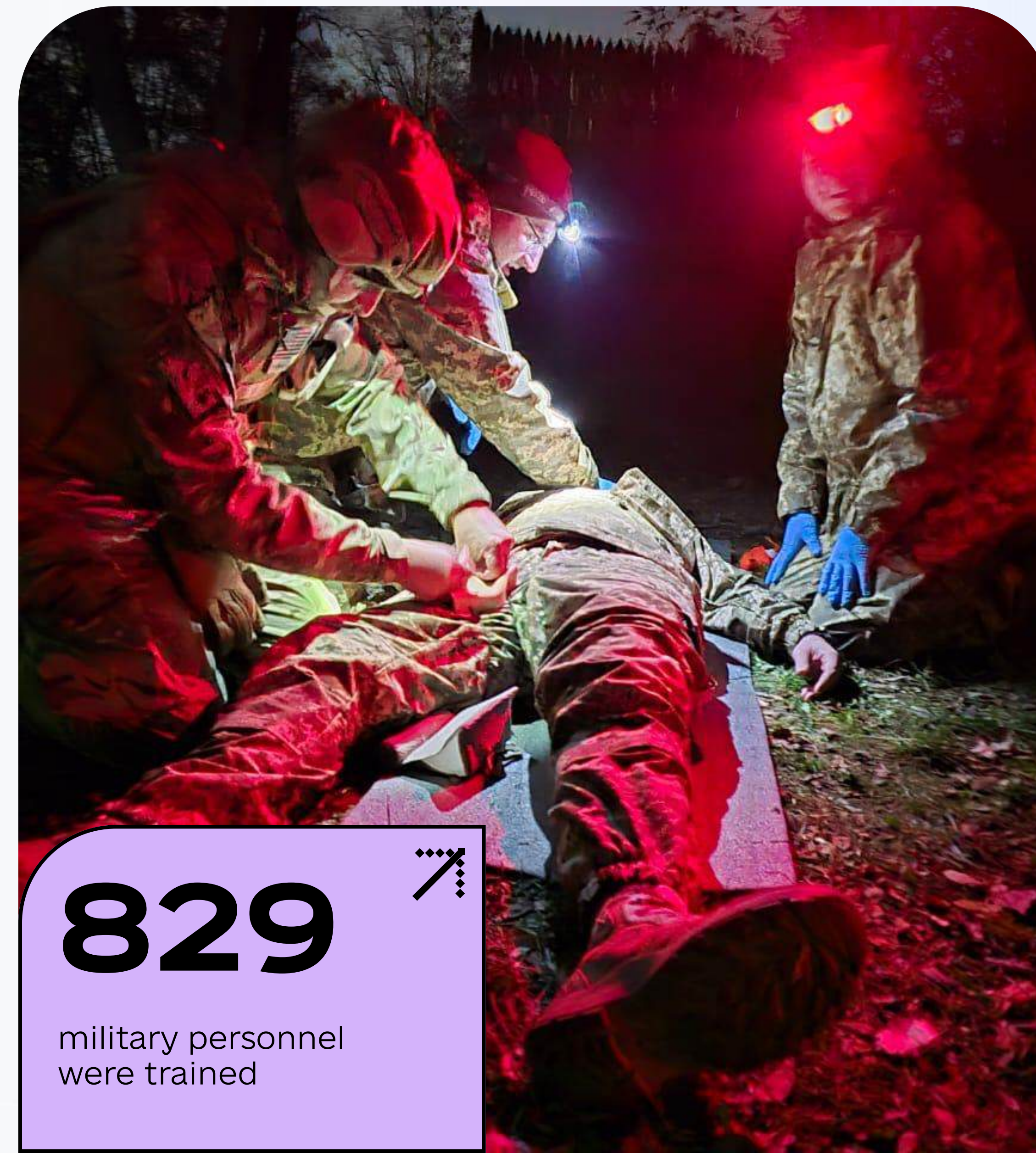
TACTICAL MEDICINE

Within the framework of the project, we train military medics to provide medical assistance at the pre-hospital stage in combat conditions.

The trainings are conducted by certified instructors with medical education and combat experience, which makes it possible to combine theory with practical skills.

Modern tactical medicine tools, specialized equipment, and trauma simulators of various levels of complexity - from burns to amputations are used during the training process.

The training takes place in conditions close to real combat environments, with the practice of stress scenarios in order to develop skills of rapid response and correct actions under pressure.

This made it possible to expand the knowledge and practical skills of pre-medical aid among various population groups, strengthening overall readiness to act in crisis situations.





Since 2014, the Non-governmental Organization “All-Ukrainian Association ‘Patriot’” has been a participant in the permanent partnership program of the Nova Poshta Humanitarian project, which was created in response to the invasion of the Russian Federation into Ukraine. Since that time, it has become a reliable logistics backbone for the volunteer movement of Ukraine.
